Lolo Pass

Approximately 420 miles

Ride Description

This ride is an extremely popular one for local Montanans! There are over 77 miles of corners to carve alongside the Lochsa River on U.S. 12 in Idaho, and if you don't want to do the whole ride, you just run out west on 12 as far as you want. For an additional leg of the trip making it more like 524 miles, take ID 14 which picks up just east of Grangeville after traveling down a rapid descent of switchbacks, it is a 50 mile each way road that will take you to Elk City. Great road with even more exciting corners than 12. It boarders the South Fork of the Clearwater River.

Directions

-Take Reserve St South to U.S. 93

After Lolo, turn right onto U.S. 12

- -South on U.S. 95 to Grangeville
- -East on ID 13
- (-East on ID 14 to Elk City
- -Turn around and retrace your path West on ID 14)
- -Then Head East on ID 14 to Kooskia
- -East on U.S. 12 to Lolo
- -And back on to 93 North to return to Missoula
