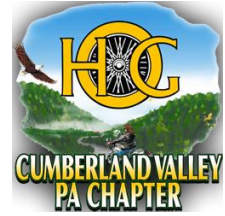


General Meeting

Head Road Captain Report

Route/Destination Planning

1. Can destination handle 50 bikes?
2. Can rest stops handle 50 bikes (e.g. fuel, bathrooms)?
3. Advertising Rides (open versus closed)
4. Ensure all Road Captains are familiar with route.
 - a. Pre-ride
 - b. H-D Ride Planner

The Ride

1. Increase meet time – 30 min to 1 hour
2. New Sign in Sheet
 - a. All makes/models welcome
 - b. Guest → Member = 3 events
3. Streamline Release form process
 - a. Make release forms available online
 - b. Electronic forms?
4. Pre-ride meeting
 - a. NO Blocking added to Road Captain checklist
 - b. Pre-Stage Groups
 - i. Divide group up among Road Captains (e.g. 50 guests, 5 Road Captains. 10 riders per Road Captain)
 - c. Road Captains will wear green stickers or bandannas for visibility
